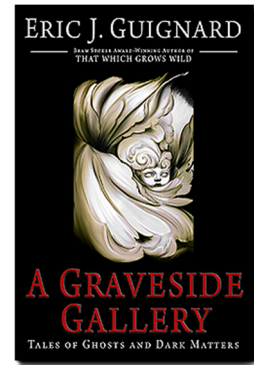

- In “Perchance to Dream in Voices of a Fiend: A Fanciful Epilogue to *Frankenstein*,” an intimate epilogue is suggested to the famous novel *Frankenstein*, offering a more hopeful closure to characters’ lives.
